**Under this agreement for 2017  
Boyne Island State School will receive**

**\$103,536\***

## This funding will be used to

- Reading –Students achieving at or above year level expectations from 73%\* to 88% by 2017  
(Measure – PM Benchmarks \*using revised 2016 standard)
- Reading –Students achieving above year level expectations maintained above 40% at 47% in 2017  
(Measure – PM Benchmarks \*using revised 2016 standard)
- Writing – Students achieving above year level expectations for writing at least 50% (Measure – Naplan writing guide)
- Students below National Minimum Standard have an evidence-based plan, developed by the class teacher and utilising support personnel, to address their specific learning needs in 2017

## Our initiatives include

- Improve instructional quality and alignment through Comprehension Accuracy Fluency and Expanded Vocabulary (CAFÉ) reading and writing and clarity on intention of Australian curriculum
- Provide a differentiated learning climate supported by teacher aides and speech language pathologist
- Develop the professional capacity of teachers and teacher aides
- Implement systems to enable the school to operate as a collegial learning organisation

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Increase access to a Speech Language Pathologist for screening and intervention	\$ 11 136 (2 hours x 30 weeks + screening)
• Increase teacher aide to provide more support and student conferencing	\$ 92 400 (55 hours x 48 weeks)
• Increase access to specialist teacher to allow for differentiation of instruction through CAFÉ writing	Master teacher
